On April 26th, Arbor Day, the Lake Worth City Tree Board will be holding the Shade Tree Give-Away. To participate, simply come by City Hall on Saturday, April 26th, starting at 10:00 a.m., Be prepared to stand in line, pick up and complete a tree waiver form promising to care for your tree, pick up a tree till gone, take it home and plant it. Any of you Board of Directors who feel they need some trees, stop by City Hall. They are not giving away palm trees.

The Friends of the Lake Worth Library's Book Sale will be held Saturday, April 26th, from 10:00 am to 4:00 pm. at the Cultural Plaza across from the library. The library is located at 15 North M St., Lake Worth.

Used books, DVDs, videos, audio cassettes, puzzles, magazines and more will be on sale from 50cents to \$5.00.

A new opportunity will begin in May, 2008 when Utility Customers can receive a **\$25 credit** for enrolling in the City's new **Automatic Monthly Payment** program. This program allows the City to initiate payment of your monthly Utility bill automatically from your bank account when it is due – no checks, no postage, no reminders or late payment fees.

Certificate of Use Program

Prior to activating new City Utility accounts for any leased property a Certificate of Use (CU) and local business tax license must be obtained from the City of Lake Worth.

Utility customers who lease property (non-owners) must obtain a CU and local business tax receipt from the City **prior** to occupancy (residential rental) or prior to a business property's change in use.

Property owners who permit any person to operate a business or who rent or lease their residential property without a current CU and local business tax receipt shall be subject to a fine if the property is occupied without this required CU and tax receipt.
